

CONSISTORY MEETING SYNOPSIS
October 10, 2010

Present: The Rev. Dr. Charles Wiessner; Intern Pastor Nola Boezeman, Elders: Chris Forte, David Francis, Ron Hamm, Bill Kalsbeek, Ed Matson. Deacons: Brooke Johnson, Mike Shafer; and Clerk: Liz White.

Motions passed during the meeting:

Approval of agenda; approval of September 14 regular meeting minutes; Consistory may, at its discretion and for a special purpose, establish a non-voting at-large position; Consistory establish a position of elder-at-large for a 3-year term with the purpose of enabling Nola Boezeman to participate more fully in all aspects of the life of the church; and adjournment. Motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented was passed at the Budget meeting on October 12.

Items of note

New Life. The library committee reported the books have been sorted and are ready for shelving. The education exploration committee is considering a program that would engage the entire congregation. Job Link Access Point served 38 people in September.
