- Through studying the Bible (John 1:1-14; John 20:30-31)
- Through a living and growing prayer life (Philippians 4:6-7; Matthew 6:6-13)

To make Christ known – to fulfill the Great Commission by encouraging others to become disciples (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8)

- Through helping others come to live in a relationship with Jesus Christ (John 1:37-49; Acts 26:28-29)
- Through sharing God's love (John 13:34-35; I John 4:7-12)
- Through sharing our hope (Hebrews 6:17-20; Romans 5:1-5)
- Through sharing Christ's teaching (Acts 8:26-38; I Corinthians 15:3-4)
- Through living as an example of Christ in our thoughts, words and deeds (James 2:14-18)

To serve all people – to open our hearts and our church to all (Mark 10:42-45; Luke 10:25-37)

- Through helping to meet the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of those in our congregation and those in our community (Matthew 25: 34-40; Acts 4:32-35)
- Through supporting local and world missions with our time, treasures, and talents (II Corinthians 9:6-15; Philippians 4:10-20)
